




EXPERIENCE HISTORY



1. Mission San Juan Capistrano Founded 1776. Tour Exhibits, Padres Quarters, Museum Rooms, Soldiers Barracks, Industrial Areas, Art Gallery, Cemetery, The Great Stone Church



2. The Capistrano Depot 26701 Verdugo Street, Santa Fe Railroad Station Circa 1894, now Amtrak & Metrolink and home to Sarducci's Restaurant.



3. Los Rios Historic District Circa 1794 The district includes 31 historic structures, many now quaint shops and restaurants.



4. Rios Adobe Circa 1794 - 31781 Los Rios St. Oldest residence continuously occupied by a single family.



5. Montanez Adobe Circa 1794. Oldest home in the district. Located in Los Rios Park.



6. Olivares Home 31791 Los Rios St. Circa 1890 Listed on the National Registry



Circa 1900. Formally Jones Family Farm



8. Garcia/Pryor House-O'Neill Museum 31831 Los Rios Street Circa 1880. Home to San Juan Capistrano Historical Society.



9. Ferris Kelly Building Circa 1930 Camino Capistrano and Ortega Hwy. Built on the old town plaza site where fiestas and bullfights where held.



10. Don Juan Avila Adobe 31831 Camino Capistrano Circa 1840. Originally a ten-room structure built by Don Juan Avila now home to Whim.



11. Garcia Adobe 31861 Camino Capistrano Circa 1830. Only twostory adobe in San Juan Capistrano.



12. Yorba Adobes Circa 1830 - 31871 & 31891 Camino Capistrano Home to El Adobe Restaurant since 1948



13. Egan House 31892 Camino Capistrano Circa 1883. Originally called "Harmony Hall" Owned by Chief Justice Richard Egan.






7. ZOOMARS Petting Zoo Completely restored 2 acre Petting Zoo.

14. Blas Aguilar Adobe 31806 El Camino Real. Circa 1794. Now a Museum. Open to the public




Graves 16. Mission Basilica Camino Capistrano at Acjachema Street. Original Mission Basilica




Capistrano Circa 1920. Only surviving structure from the commercial ice business. Now Dynasty Collections & Antiques.




